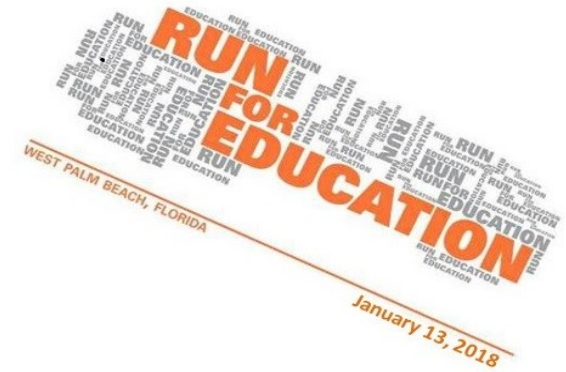

This event will take place on January 13, 2018, at Micanopy Pavilion, Okeeheelee Park, in West Palm Beach, Florida.

The Abi Kattel Memorial Foundation is a 501(C)(3) non-profit, charitable organization established in the memory of Abi Kattel, who passed away at the age of twenty-two. This foundation promotes the ideals of helping further education and altruism.

The foundation has been helping Earthquake victims in Nepal as per its objectives of helping the community. Accordingly, a portion of proceeds from this event will be dedicated to rehabilitate and reconstruct schools in Nepal. Currently, the foundation has been focusing on starting a school in Sankhu near Kathmandu, Nepal. The devastating earthquakes of April and May 2015 claimed nearly 9,000 lives, injured more than 22,000 people and left 800,000 people affected.
